Courses and Entry Requirements 2025

- The general entry requirement for Trinity Sixth Form is five or more Level 5s-9s (or equivalent) including grade 4 in English & Maths.
- For students wishing to take vocational qualifications **only** five or more 4-9 (or equivalent) are accepted.
- If students have achieved a grade 3 in English or Maths, they can re-sit this qualification alongside a vocational Level 3 pathway.

A-Level Courses:

- It is recommended that students have a Level 6 at GCSE in their chosen subject/closely related subject.
- **Please note, a level 7 is recommended for Further Maths**

GCSE English and Mathematics:

- Students will be required to retake Mathematics **or** English GCSE qualifications if they have not been achieved at GCSE Grade 4 or above.
- Students will need to have achieved a grade 3 to access the resit GCSE Mathematics and English courses.
